The PTA reports to the Senior Physiotherapist and follows the physiotherapist’s treatment plan when providing care to patients and residents.

Qualifications

Graduate of an approved Physiotherapy Assistant Education Accreditation Program is preferred. If there are no applicants from an accredited program, applicants from the following disciplines will be considered based on education and experience:

- Registered Nurse
- Registered Practical Nurse
- Other health field with anatomy course requirement

In addition, applicants must demonstrate experience in the following:

- Strong interpersonal skills, and able to work collaboratively with an inter-professional team
- Demonstrate good interpersonal skills as incumbent must maintain regular communication with patients/residents, families, staff and visitors
- Excellent organizational and time management skills
- Demonstrated ability to attend work on a regular and sustained basis
- Ability to be flexible and adapt positively to constantly changing situations
- Excellent communication skills, advocacy skills, conflict resolution, critical thinking and problem-solving skills
- High level of initiative and self-direction with strong organizational qualities
- Participate as an active team member in our ongoing focus of a culture of patient and resident safety
