The Hospital provides inpatient acute care, long term and chronic care services, 24 hour emergency services including emergency labour and delivery, cardiac care including telemetry, rehab and stress testing, palliative care, medical day care, diagnostic services (laboratory, radiography, ultrasound, pulmonary function testing), rehab services including [physiotherapy, occupational therapy, dietician, diabetes outreach services, foot care, and specialist clinics and services – both on-site and via the Ontario Telemedicine Network.

The Nipigon District Family Health Team (FHT) is one of 180 Family Health Teams across the Province of Ontario working towards a vision that all Ontarians will have timely access to high-quality, comprehensive team-based primary care in their local community. The primary mandate is to improve access to primary health care for the communities served through our catchment through innovative leadership, resulting in health care initiatives that contribute to a system that will maximize the resources available for patient care.
