Nipigon District Memorial Hospital (NDMH) is reporting that a respiratory outbreak has been declared in the Long Term Care Unit as of February 2, 2024. A respiratory outbreak is declared when two confirmed positive cases are connected. The individuals who have tested positive for the respiratory virus are currently in self-isolation.

NDMH Update:

NDMH will be implementing outbreak management measures, including increased infection prevention and control practices and surveillance testing for affected individuals.

All residents, along with NDMH staff who work in the Long Term Care Unit, will be closely monitored for symptoms and undergo wellness checks.

To help contain any further spread of the virus, NDMH will be limiting visitation of one person per resident at a time. All visitors must check in at the nursing station prior to visiting and will be required to wear hospital provided personal protective equipment (PPE).

NDMH will be working closely with the Thunder Bay District Health Unit to manage the outbreak and to protect patients, residents, staff and visitors.
